Animation Festival ICONA 2019 in Corfu

November 29 – December 1, 2019, Department of Audiovisual Arts, Ionian University

The Ionian Contemporary Animation (ICONA 2019) Festival was successfully finished on Sunday, December 1, 2019. The Festival was organized from November 29 to December 1, 2019 in the city of Corfu by the Department of Audiovisual Arts, Ionian University within the framework of the CIAK ("Common Initiatives to AcKnowledge and valorize tourism potential of the programme area through cinema") Project. The festival program included both professional and student competitions. A total number of 135 films was screened (72 short-length and 63 student movies) originating from 48 countries all over the world.

The special artistic committee (Konstantinos Tiligadis - Ionian University, Vassilis Karamitsanis – Head of the ASIFA Hellas and Panagiotis Kyriakoulakos - University of the Aegean) evaluated the movies and awarded the following prizes:

The successful organization of the ICONA festival supports the future plans of the Department of Audiovisual Arts towards the annual hosting of the event, based on the academic activities (education and research) of the department within the creative field of animation.

CIAK project, funded for around 900.000 euro by Interreg V-A Greece-Italy Programme 2014-2020, aims to promote the territory of the involved regions (Regions of Ionian Islands, Western Greece and Epirus in Greece and Puglia Region in Italy), through initiatives linked to the cinema and audiovisual sector. The valorization of the natural and cultural heritage through short movies, documentaries, fiction, animations about the common story of Italy and Greece will improve the touristic attractiveness of the area by supporting a cross-border community composed of the creative industry operators.

Apulia Film Commission Foundation is the lead beneficiary of this project in cooperation with four greek partners, the Region of Epirus, the Region of Ionian Islands, the Region of Western Greece and the Ionian University – Research Committee. Associated partner is Puglia Region Department for Economy of Culture, Tourism and Valorization of Territory.

Ionian University is a CIAK project partner, represented by the Department of Audiovisual Arts, that is responsible for the organization of the planned educational activities starting in 2019, as well as of theme-specific festivals.
